The Adjudication of L-1B "Specialized Knowledge" Worker Petitions: How Is It Working for You? Tuesday, February 7, 2012 2:00 - 3:00 p.m. EST

The L-1B classification allows an employer to petition for an employee who has "specialized knowledge" of the employer's products, services, research, equipment, techniques, management, or other interests and its application in international markets, or expertise in the employer's processes and procedures, from a qualified affiliated entity outside the United States.
